

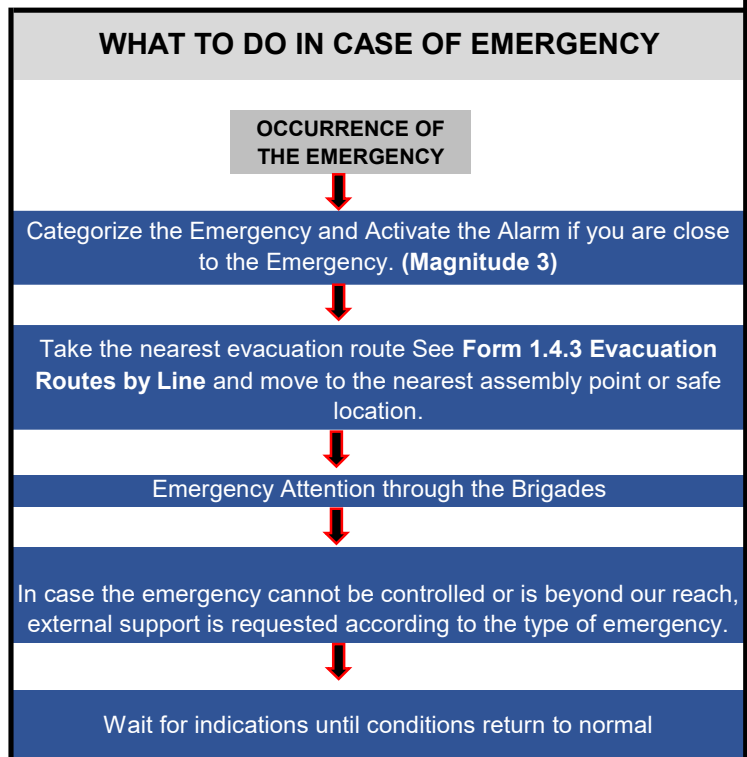

WITHDRAWAL ACTIONS

DURING AN ARMED CONFLICT

1. Find a place to hide that is out of sight of the shooter, provide protection if shots are fired in your direction (This could be an office with a door that can be closed).

2. Do not try to catch the shooter

3. Close the door and block it with heavy furniture.

4. If the shooter is nearby:
Silence your cell phone.
Turn off any sources of noise (i.e., radios, televisions).
Hide behind large furniture (i.e., cabinets, desks).
Stay quiet

5. If evacuation and sheltering are not possible:
Remain calm.
Dial 911, if possible, to alert police of the shooter's presence.
If you cannot speak, leave the line open and let the operator hear you.

6. Wait to be rescued.
